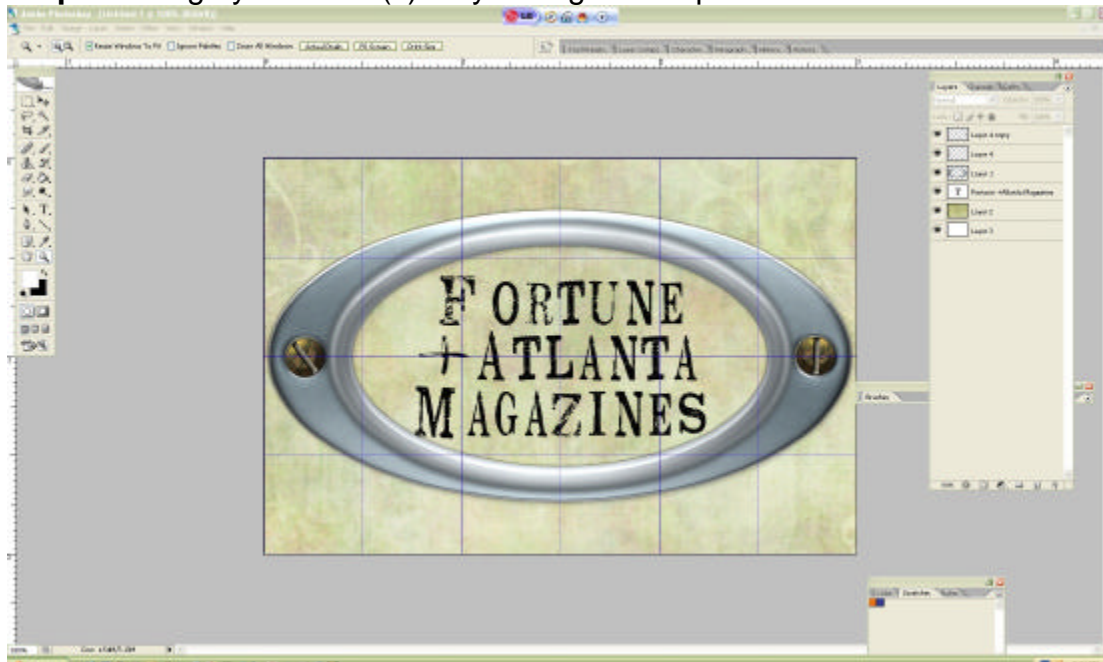


Craft Tutorial: Making Labels Using Your Digital Scrapbook Place Elements

This tutorial will show you how to use your DSP products to design labels for unlimited uses around your home and in your life.

Step 1: Design your Label(s) on your digital scrapbook software

Step 2: Print out your label(s) on a cardstock or heavy stock paper and cut them out.



Step 3: Use a self-sealing laminating sheet only the sticky part not the hard plastic. You can also use packing tape. I've used Scotch® Brand Self-Sealing Laminating Pouches, but any brand will work.



Step 4: Trim off all the excess laminating film by cutting around the edges of the label. The front of the label should now be shiny and protected from water and finger oils, etc.

Step 5: Use adhesive to make your label into a sticker. I've used a Xyron® Sticker Machine with a permanent adhesive cartridge. You could use a glue stick, rubber cement, or another form of adhesive.



Step 6: Apply your label. I'm labeling my wooden magazine holders.
